FEES AND DUTIES (GOVERNMENT FEES) ORDER 2021

Laid before Tynwald: 16 March 2021
Coming into Operation: 1 April 2021

The Treasury makes the following Order under section 81 of the Interpretation Act 2015.

1 Title

This Order is the Fees and Duties (Government Fees) Order 2021.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 1 April 2021¹.

3 Fees payable

- (1) For each of the numbered matters set out in the table in the Schedule there shall be charged the fee set out in the Fee column in respect of each matter.
- (2) All fees specified in the table in the Schedule are outside the scope of VAT unless shown otherwise in the 'VAT' column corresponding to each entry in the table.

4 Revocation

The Fees and Duties (Government Fees) Order 2020² is revoked.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE**(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order, which is made under the Interpretation Act, increases the fees to be collected in relation to a number of common functions exercised in some Departments, Statutory Boards or Offices. The fees were last increased in 2020.

All fees were increased by 2% (with an element of rounding down) in line with general budget assumptions for income collected in 2021/22.
