LIQUOR LICENSING AND PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENTS (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2023

Laid before Tynwald:

Coming into Operation: in accordance with regulation 2

The Department of Home Affairs makes the following Regulations under section 60 of the Liquor Licensing and Public Entertainments Act 2021.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Liquor Licensing and Public Entertainments (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2023.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on the day after they are made¹.

3 Amendment of the Liquor Licensing and Public Entertainment (Fees) Regulations 2022

- (1) The Liquor Licensing and Public Entertainment (Fees) Regulations 2022² are amended as follows.
- (2) In Schedule 3 (licence fees), in Table 1 (annual licence fees), in the entry for Public entertainment licence, in the third column (annual fee £)—
 - (a) for “52.00” substitute **£17.50**;
 - (b) for “36.50” substitute **£12.00**; and
 - (c) for “1124” substitute **£374.50**.
